~ THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK ~

In 1977 at the height of the Cold War, Anatoly Shcharansky, a brilliant young mathematician and chess player, was arrested by the KGB for his repeated attempts to immigrate to Israel. He spent thirteen years inside the Soviet gulag. From morning to evening he read and studied all 150 Psalms. “What does this give me?” he was asked in a letter. “Gradually, my feeling of great loss and sorrow changes to one of bright hopes.”

He so cherished his book of Psalms, in fact, that when guards took it away from him, he lay in the snow, refusing to move, until they returned it. During those thirteen years, his wife traveled around the world campaigning for his release. Accepting an honorary degree on his behalf, she told the university audience, “In a lonely cell in prison, locked alone with the Psalms of David, Anatoly found expression for his innermost feelings in the outpourings of the King of Israel thousands of years ago.

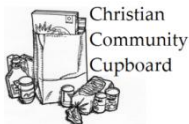
